Swimming Pool Building

OUALIFICATION DEVELOPMENT - JUNE 2025



A New Zealand qualification for swimming pool building will enhance industry reputation, and support employee retention by providing clear career pathways. The formal qualification will ensure a consistent level of expertise, improve service quality, and create a more attractive and sustainable industry for current and future employees. This will lead to the end-users gaining more trust and respect in the quality of delivery.

What are we doing?

Waihanga Ara Rau¹, with the support of SPASA and industry representatives, will lead a process that meets NZQA's listing requirements and will consult with industry for development of a qualification in swimming pool building.

The qualification will recognise trade competence for the building and installation of swimming pools, with a focus on domestic/residential swimming pools. It may also include installation of different types of pools, such as:

- Fiberglass
- Concrete
- Above Ground
- Pre-cast

Scope

This scope of the project is development and registration of the qualification for swimming pool building. This will include identifying the individual skill sets that would lead to a person being a competent swimming pool builder. Where skill standards² exist that describe the skill sets, they will be listed in the qualification. Waihanga Ara Rau will document the remaining key skills and recommend these for skill standard development to the Industry Skills Board (ISB)³.

How are we doing this?

Waihanga Ara Rau will complete the project in stages to help provide project clarity as we prepare for transition to Industry Skills Boards (ISBs).

The previously completed stages are:

Development of <u>Core Construction skill standards</u>.
